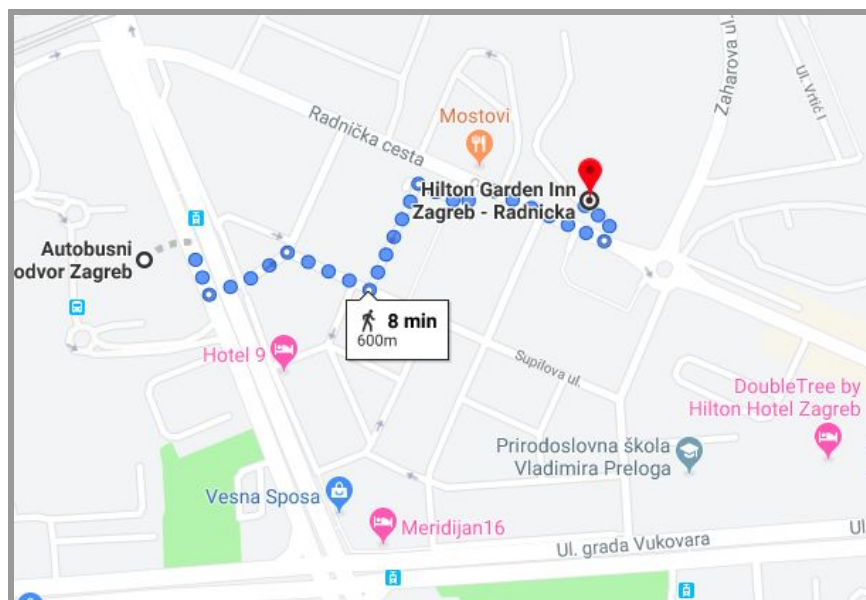

How to Arrive

- From Franjo Tuđman airport:
- By transfer (if purchased on registration)
- By shuttle bus departing every half hour (40 min ride) to the central bus station. See the timetable [here](#).
- From central bus station (Autobusni Kolodvor Zagreb) to the Hilton Garden Inn is 600m/ [8 minutes by foot](#).
- From railway station: ([Glavni Kolodvor](#)) is just behind the bus station

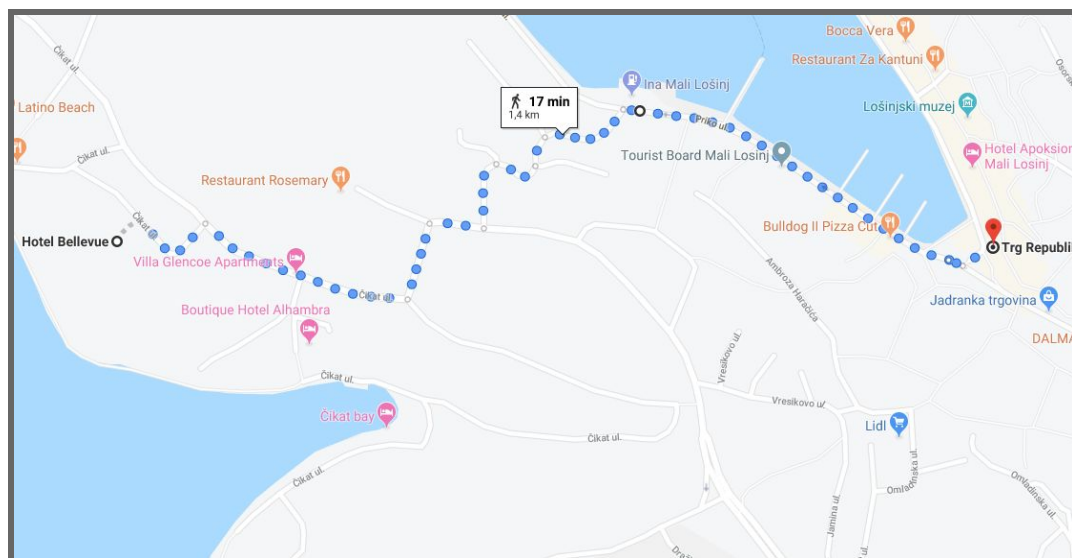

During the month of October, high temperatures average 20°C with lows around 11°C. Days may be partly sunny or cloudy, with rain and wind possible.

Currency

Croatia uses the Kuna, which is valued at approximately 1 Euro equaling 7.4 Croatian Kunas. ATMs are abundant in both Zagreb and Mali Lošinj.

Language

The official language in Croatia is Croatian. It belongs to Slavic group of languages. However, foreign languages, especially English, German, and Italian, are widely spoken.

Electricity

Electrical supply is 230V, 50Hz AC. Croatia uses the standard European (round-pronged) plugs.

Phone Communication

Croatia has 3 commercial systems of mobile phone networks; and each of them have sim cards for tourists available at shops and airports.
